The Outstanding Gender, Sexualities, and Women's Studies Graduate Award

This annual \$1,000 award recognizes an outstanding graduate student in the Women's Studies MA program who has an excellent record of scholarship and professional development. MA students in their second-year in the program are eligible for this award. Applicants should submit 1) a 1-2 page CV, 2) an unofficial transcript, and 3) a brief statement, no more than one page, double-spaced describing excellence of their scholarly work and how the applicant meets the following criteria of excellence:

Criteria:

We assess applicants based on all criteria to select those students who best qualify. Reviewers will favorably consider applications that demonstrate:

- An outstanding record of work as a graduate student (including but not limited to coursework, MA degree projects, representing the Center professionally. Please include an unofficial copy of transcripts)
- Scholarly productivity (including published papers, professional presentations, grant proposals, etc.)
- Record of praxis (activism, cultural production, community engagement, etc.)
- Engagement in Center activities (attending workshops, coordinating events, etc.)
